## Special Leave for Students

We frequently hear that children were reported sick when in fact they were not sick but were away for a long weekend with their parents.

Compulsory education insists that we be stricter about this and report such cases as "unauthorized absence." Truancy and staying home without a valid reason, including being late and going on vacation during school time without special leave, are considered unauthorized absences.

If your child is sick, needs to go to the doctor, dentist, orthodontist, or other (para)medical appointments, this must be reported at the latest at the beginning of the school day.

Both parents and the school risk a fine if they do not comply with the compulsory education law. The school is required to report unauthorized absences to the compulsory education officer.

## Compulsory Education Law

Within families, organizations, institutions, and education, agreements are made. This makes it clear what everyone can expect and allows everyone to choose moments for relaxation within those agreements. In education, an annual schedule (national and regional) is made for school holidays and free days.

Schools also create an internal schedule with study days, etc., based on this planning. The Compulsory Education Law prohibits students from taking leave outside of school holidays. Leave requests are only granted based on specific circumstances designated by compulsory education. If the reason for the requested leave does not fall under these circumstances, the request will not be granted. If parents still go on vacation despite this, it is considered luxury absence. This is a violation of the compulsory education law. The school must report this type of absence to the compulsory education officer, who will then draw up an official report followed by a fine.

Additionally, compulsory education officers can always make random visits to schools to inquire about which students are absent and the reasons for their absence. We provide you with this information to avoid unpleasant situations.
